## GOVERNMENT SUBSIDIES

Government subsidies, for eligible clients, are available from the Ministry of Children and Family Development or the Ministry of Human Resources and Skills Development. It is the parent/guardian’s responsibility to renew the authorizations. If confirmation of your renewal are not received by the first week of the month, we will consider payment your responsibility.

## FULLY QUALIFIED DAYCARE STAFF

The lead Early Childhood Educator is fully licensed with the Provincial Community Care Facilities Licensing Board. One or more staff is a qualified Early Childhood Educator or Assistant to the lead Early Childhood Educator.

The daycare staff are responsible for providing a program that will focus on each child’s needs and development. This will include a variety of opportunities, stimulating experiences, and a safe, healthy environment.
